### E-SMS Version 1.10.635

#### Bug Fixes

Home

- Users can now have multiple tabs of E-SMS open in the same web session.
- Negatively numbered notifications no longer appear in the Notifications queue.
- The “Frequently Visited” and “Recently Visited” sections now appear empty for first-time E-SMS users.

Work

- In Work Analysis, running a profile no longer overwrites existing work item candidates.

### E-SMS Version 1.10.636

#### Bug Fixes

Assess

- Users can now successfully create a component from the asset tab in a workspace.
- The “Loading” icon now appears in its correct location when assessments are selected.

Catalog

- Template Bindings now disappear when they are removed from an Assessment Template.

Documents

- Tags no longer obscure document instructions on the Documents page.
- Users can now filter by Owning Site field on the Documents Search page.

## Home

- Maintenance notification banners are now separated from the “CUI” (Controlled Unclassified Information) banner in the E-SMS Web App.
- Clearing an organization from the Current Organization selector now redirects users to the Home page.

## Inventory

- Users with Administrator, Curator, Assessment Supervisor, and Workspace Assessor permissions can now create, update, and delete documents.
- Area Cost Factors now appear as decimals instead of whole numbers on the Site page.
- Asset and Component searches now execute successfully from their respective search pages.
- The “Permissions” tab now updates a parent organization’s permissions successfully after selecting a parent link from a sub-organization’s detail page.
- Inventory fields are now visible throughout the Web App when “Dark Mode” is engaged.
- Images now load for Organization and Site Administrators who have not been assigned to a workspace or a team.
- Rolling up a group with multiple assets now successfully updates PRV and CI values for that group.
- Users can now create components associated with user-created (not imported) assets.

## Work

- Users can now navigate to and edit Work Items Detail pages without a “Failed to Load Funding” error message appearing.

## **Feature Updates & Improvements**

### Assess

- When viewing on the Firefox browser, tables on a workspace now display as expected.

## Home

- Users' displayed names are now configurable and default to the EAMS "Personal Display Name" when possible.

## Inventory

- The "Select Organization" menu now displays organizations in a "tree" view that lists them in Parent > Child order.
- The Site Name filter now lets users select multiple items instead of choosing them via a text search.

## Work

- Creating and saving a new profile at Work > Work Analysis > Profile > Add Profile no longer generates a "404 - Page Not Found" or "Failed to Update the Profile" error.

# E-SMS Version 1.10.637

## Bug Fixes

### Home

- Users are now automatically signed out of the E-SMS Web App after 15 minutes while working in a separate browser tab.

### Inventory

- The Map feature on Inventory Search pages is now responsive to better fit smaller screens.
- Users can now apply filters to the Installation column at Inventory > Site.
- Selecting a section detail opens a modal that now displays all fields associated with the section detail, not just default table values.

## Feature Updates & Improvements

### Inventory

- An "Assessment Date" field has been added to assessment dropdowns on the Asset Detail and Component Detail pages.

- Dropdowns on Inventory Detail pages now have the same field order as Inventory Search pages.
- The “Download CSV” and “Select Columns” buttons are now available on Inventory Detail tables.
- “Custom Attributes” and “Properties” sections have been combined into a single dropdown on Inventory Detail pages.

## **E-SMS Version 1.10.638**

### **Bug Fixes**

#### Assess

- Workspace-based assessment images now save and load successfully.
- The “Workspace Status” column is now listed first in all workspace component tables to match asset tables.

#### Home

- Users can no longer interact with greyed out buttons in lists (such as deleting service life specifications on the Service Life Reference Book page).
- Scrolling now works properly in the list of default domains in Settings > User Preferences.

#### Inventory

- The scrollbar now loads reliably on the Components Search page on larger monitors.
- Scrollbars are now available from all accordion menus on the Inventory Detail pages.

### **Feature Updates & Improvements**

#### Home

- Search pages now utilize infinite scroll virtualization for better performance.

### **Field App**

#### **Bug Fixes**

##### Assess

- When a user creates a new component and a new assessment in the Field App, and then upsyns, the assessment is now available to other users after downsyncing.
- Search filters are now cleared in the Field App when users switch between different workspaces.

##### Home

- The Field App now times out after 15 minutes of inactivity to comply with DoW standards.

##### Inventory

- Upsyns from the Field App involving deleting components now succeed.
- Unneeded white spaces no longer appear when editing section details in the Field App.

### **Feature Updates & Improvements**

- The “Color,” “Completed,” and “Revisit” columns on the Field App’s “Component Search” screen now take up less space on all displays.

### **Field App**

#### **Bug Fixes**

##### Assess

- Deleting an assessment in the Field App and then upsyns now results in the assessment being deleted from the workspace.
- Color Code updates now appear after syncing assessments or components in the Field App or Web App.

##### Home

- In the Field App, an exclamation point now appears on the sync button when local changes have been made.
- Local user information is now retained after logging out of the Field App.
- Resyns to the Field App after logging out and logging back in works as expected.

## Inventory

- Component list searches in the Field App now return results on partial matches.
- The “Create Asset” form’s default “Operational Status” is now “Active” in the Field App.
- Navigation bar button spacing is now consistent on the Field App’s Asset Search page.
  
- Empty tables in the component or asset views are no longer clickable in the Field App.
- Components now load successfully after the first sync in the Field App.
- Component tables now refresh automatically after asset or system filters are applied in the Field App.

## Feature Updates & Improvements

### Assess

- Name templates are now editable in the Field App. Sections of the template that require manual entries or updates are automatically highlighted upon user selection.
- Templates can now be left blank to disable them in the Field App.
- The “Create Assessment” quick action button has been changed to “Create Distress Survey” in the Field App.
- The “System Filter” tool is now called the “Classification Filter” in both the Field App and the Web App.
- The “Classification Filter” now filters down to the fourth level (sub-elements) of the UNIFORMAT hierarchy. (e.g. A1011 Wall Foundations).
- The “System” column is now called “Classification” on the Component Search screen in both the Field App and the Web App and allows filtering down to the fourth level of the UNIFORMAT hierarchy.

### Inventory

- Asset Edit buttons are now spaced more evenly in the Field App.
- MDI and CII fields are hidden on Component Edit pages for users with Workspace Assessor permissions in the Field App.

- In the Field App, Component Search tables are now sorted by default to “System,” “Specification,” and “Name.”

##### Assess

- Dropdown values now appear when users add a Distress Rating to an Assessment in the Field App.

##### Inventory

- Asset filters applied at the Component Search screen are now applied automatically along with their corresponding domain when creating a component in the Field App.

##### Inventory

- Component Search System Filters are now carried over to the Component Type, Classification, and Specification fields on New Component pages in the Field App.
