## E-SMS Version 1.10.612

### Bug Fixes

#### Inventory

- The Weather Impact button on the Component Details page now performs as expected.
- Users with curator permissions can now create Component Importance books.
- All asset associations now load as expected.

#### Work

- Defined asset scopes are no longer required to generate work data.
- Work planners can successfully generate work data.
- If user-entered minimum cost values are equal to or greater than calculated costs, they are now used and prioritized in Work Analysis.

### Performance Enhancements

#### Rollups

- Rollup speed has increased.

### Feature Updates & Improvements

#### Inventory

- Selecting “Show Graphs” on the Component Search page now displays system summary graphs instead of component type graphs.
- Managed components can now be assigned to individual groups that belong to a single site.
- Tables on the Inventory, Work Item, and Assessment Detail pages now have the same filter options as their search pages.

#### Reference Books

- Administrators and Curators can now see parent organization reference books, and Work Planners can now select reference books from parent organizations in Work Analysis.

### **Feature Updates & Improvements**

#### Inventory

- Assets or components can be added to named groups.
- Users can see the groups to which an asset or component belongs on their respective Detail page.

#### Work

- New work items can now be created at the Work Item Detail page.

### **Bug Fixes**

#### Inventory

- Groups can now be deleted by selecting “Delete Groups” on the Group Detail page.

#### Work

- Work Plan search results now update as expected after changing domains via the Domain Selector on the side navigation menu.
- The Project Manager field now enables for non-DLA projects.

#### Reference Books

- Service Life values now save as expected for Service Life books.
